- Dr. Jewitt is a very inspiring and a kind professor. His lectures are very clear and engaging. He definitely cares that students are understanding the material being covered, and he carries his passion for the subject matter into the lecture hall. He's very welcoming/approachable and responsive to questions. I absolutely enjoyed Dr. Jewitt's lectures.
- Dr. Jewitt's combination of passion and humor made his lectures a joy. He did not care about teaching to the test; he just wanted us to understand the material. This made lectures much more fun and, in turn, made it easier to understand concepts and succeed on tests. I have no weaknesses to report. Dr. Jewitt was a joy to learn from.
- Dr. Jewitt, though a bit disorganized in lecture, is an enthusiastic and interesting professor that never bores.

Prof. Jewitt keeps students engaged and provides valuable demonstrations of the concepts he explains, such as resonance. Questions are welcomed and explained thoughtfully. Assigned readings are relevant and interesting. Note: his demonstrations are extremely appreciated and helpful in retaining information.

Possible suggestion: review questions that are more similar to questions found on quizzes.

- Professor Jewitt never fails to engage with the class and bring interest to the topic. I enjoy his teaching style as he incorporates modern takes on the topic, as well as includes videos of himself to further explain. Jewitt is a great instructor.
- Professor Jewitt was my favorite professor in this cluster. When teaching he taught with such clarity, and one thing I really admired was the examples he used when teaching. The concepts were at time complex but he would connect that concept with a real-life example and do it so well that I would get the concept right off the bat. Many times I find myself confused about a concept and thinking back to his examples was all it took to get the clarity I needed. His lectures were always interesting, clear, and very well organized. At times the concepts themselves didn't catch my attention, but his way of teaching allowed me to stay focused throughout the lecture. I would definitely take another class taught by Professor Jewitt.
- Professor Jewitt was very helpful in understanding the material as he summarized the slides in a more comprehensible way. He also provided resources to further understand the topic we were learning in class outside of class.
- Professor Jewitt's greatest strength was probably the charming sense of humor that he brought to his lectures, be it through his occasional corny jokes or comical real-world video clips that provided a reference point for the scientific phenomena he described, because he made the often overwhelming nature of the science of the universe engaging. Professor Jewitt was also a friendly instructor who was receptive to fielding student questions, to the extent that he would send out emails after class with more developed explanations that we had not had time to cover. With that said, Professor Jewitt had a tendency to move far too quickly through the more informational (notes) portions his lectures, which made it difficult to fully grasp new material.
- This instructor cares about our learning and wants us to be passionate about this course and science. However, sometimes the timing for this instructor's lectures weren't great, so the end of the lecture might be rushed and/or slides somewhere else in the lecture might be rushed through.
- This instructor has very engaging lectures and a great sense of humor that makes his classes much more enjoyable.
